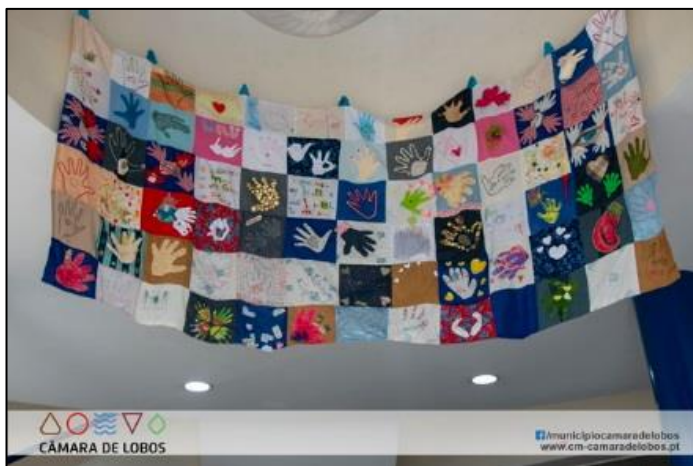

<i>Câmara de Lobos Municipal Council as in previous years celebrated the Municipal Equality Day, an aim included in the Plan of Action for Social Cohesion 2018-2021. This year, this theme was jointly marked with the "National Celebrations of the 70 years of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and the 40 years of the Portuguese ratification of the European Convention on Human Rights" on November 9. Organized activities included a keynote speech by the Europe Direct Madeira Information Center (CIEDM), and a presentation of the results of the study "Characterization of the Level of Dependency and Quality of Life of the Elderly in the Areas of Higher Social Vulnerability in the Municipality (county) of Câmara de Lobos ", by the School of Nursing S. José de Cluny, and an exhibition entitled " Free and Equal". The latter aims to introduce reflection on the crucial importance of human rights in a free and democratic society, calling for the active involvement and participation of citizens.</i>

<i>The municipality invited the local institutions to develop works in plastic arts to the subject of the human rights and 8 acceded promptly. These works helped organize the "Free and Equal" exhibition that was visited by schools and institutions for a week, in the town hall. As part of these celebrations, 2 awareness sessions on human rights were held, aimed at students between the ages of 10 and 14, adults and the elderly.</i>

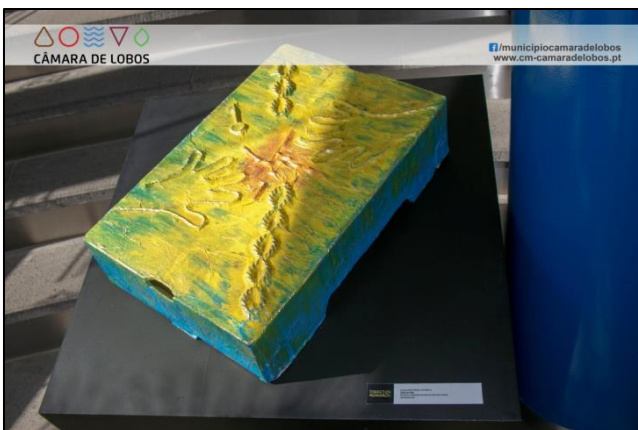

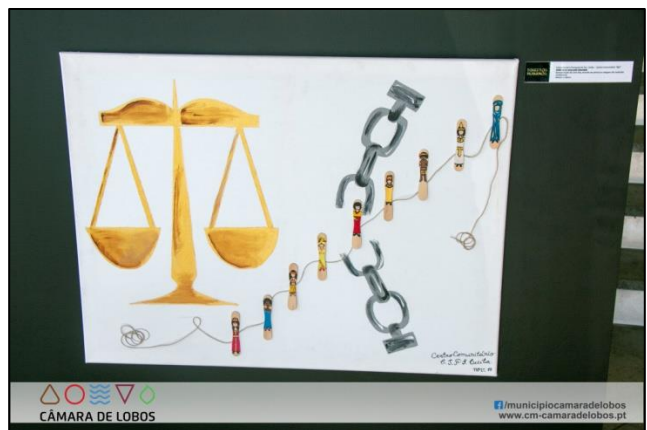
