

**UNIVERSITI SAINS MALAYSIA PEACE STUDY COURSE  
18-26 AUGUST 2019**

In order to not repeat the tragedy of Hiroshima, it is important to develop human resources who can contribute to the abolition of nuclear weapons and the establishment of world peace, through providing young people an opportunity to learn first-hand the realities of atomic bombings, the in human nature of nuclear weapons and the miseries of war. In this course, students will examine the realities of atomic bombing through visits to Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum and Hiroshima National Peace Memorial Hall for the Atomic Bomb Victims. Students will also have the opportunity to understand first-hand as to why Hibakusha (A-bomb survivors) do not want any other people in the world to experience the tragedies that they experienced, by listening to Hibakusha testimonies and the Recitation Session of Remembrance of the A-bombing. Students will learn the threat and inhumane nature of nuclear weapons, along with examining the various problems in abolishing nuclear weapons during lectures at Hiroshima City University. This program is implemented once a year with the support of Hiroshima City University on a basis of Memorandum of Understanding.
