Mayors for Peace, launched by the Mayor of Hiroshima in 1982, envisaged a new program to promote the Solidarity of Cities toward the total abolition of nuclear weapons. Cities were thus offered a way to transcend national borders and work together to press for nuclear abolition.

Mayors for Peace, and its international 2020 Vision Campaign, now numbers nearly 7,000 members in 161 countries, all committed to working in partnership for a world in which nuclear weapons are abolished and all cities are protected from the Scourge of War.
