## **Brief City Profile**

### <u>Muntinlupa City</u>

- Southernmost City in the National Capital Region (NCR) a.k.a. Metro Manila
- Land Area: 46.7 square kilometers
- Composition
  9 Barangays or Villages
- Population: 504,509 (2015 Census)





## Establishment of Muslim Affairs Office

### **Muslim Profile in the City**

- Total population of 3,810 individuals
- 3 groups or tribes: Maranao, Maguindanaon and Tausug
- **7 Mosques** established in different parts of the city
- Economic activity is mostly on retail of goods





## Establishment of Muslim Affairs Office

#### Executive Order 16, s. 2014

- The City recognizes the culture, traditions, employment opportunities, access to services, right to peace and order, comfort and convenience of Muslim residents in the City.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Local Government in the Country to establish Muslim Affairs Office



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.

PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE MUNTINLUPA CITY MUSLIM AFFAIRS OFFICE, ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS

WHEREAS, Section 23, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that, "The State shall encourage non-governmental, communitybased, or sectoral organizations that promote the welfare of the nation; (emphasis supplied)"

WHEREAS, Section 16, Chapter 2 of the Republic Act No. 7160 (Local Government Code of 1991) provides that, "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessaryly implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfsire. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support langing other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encouring and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological justice, promote full employment among their residentis, maintain peace and ottler, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants,"



# Census of Muslim residents in the city

Database Management

#### □ Social Integration Services

- Health Care Services
- Scholarship and Educational Assistance
- Peace and Order (capacitating and organizing Salam Police Volunteers)
- Orientation on Sharia and other related laws





#### Economic Integration Services

- Business fora and dialogues with Muslim vendors
- Livelihood skills trainings
- Micro-finance zero-interest loan, and other capacity-building activities







#### Other Services:

- Quarterly meetings and consultations with Muslim leaders
- Support to celebrations like International Peace Day, International Children's Day, *Eid ul-Fitr* and *Eid al-Adha*









#### Other Services

- Inclusion of Peace Education in all junior high schools in Muntinlupa City
- Assistance in cash and in kind to Marawi Siege survivors in relief and rehabilitation works
- PhP 5 Million every year to support education of Marawi children, in the next 5 years.

#### **Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS)**

- an organized process of data gathering, assisted by DILG and DLS-CSB:
  - 1) to diagnose the extent of poverty at local level;
  - 2) to determine the causes;
  - 3) to formulate appropriate intervention programs;
  - to target eligible beneficiaries; and
  - 5) to assess the impacts.








CBMS results showed the local poverty incidence at **7.8%** (in 2015), comprising **5,981** households, and their geographic locations.

It was a little larger than national government census with **5.7%** poverty incidence for NCR or Metro Manila.

- Educational assistance and scholarship
- Housing program
- Health and sanitation programs
- Nutrition (feeding program)










## **Program Outcomes and Impacts**

- Effects and impacts of programs undergo continuous validation thru surveys and data gathering to assess increase in incomes, improvement in social condition and overall quality of life.
  - Scholarship program become inclusive with around 50,000 beneficiaries from primary, secondary, tertiary and even post-graduate students.
  - Around 6,000 micro-entrepreneurs benefitting from zero-interest microfinance loan assistance.
  - Decreasing incidence of malnutrition in the past 4 years
