



Registration Guide

Restrictions on travel to Japan	In Japan, there are currently restrictions on entry to the country aimed at preventing the spread of COVID-19. Current information regarding these restrictions can be found on our online registration site. If travel to Japan is difficult, please consider joining us online (no registration fees required).
Registration Period	10:00 AM June 20 (Mon) to August 26 (Fri), 2022
How to Register	Please register online using the login ID and password provided to your city. The Mayors for Peace Secretariat will send them before the registration opens . Registration Fee	8,000 JPY will be required for each participant. Note 2: No fee will be required for those participating online, as well as non-participating companions, such as spouses and children of participants.
Arrangements by the Host	The host will provide: shuttle bus transportation between around the hotel (booked via our online registration site) and the conference venue, food and drink at the (seated) Welcome Reception, <i>bentō</i> lunch on October 20 (Thu), and refreshments (drinks) at rest areas. Note 3: Travel costs between the participants' city and Hiroshima, accommodation fees, and other expenses are to be borne by the participants.
Hotel Reservations	Hotel reservations for those staying between October 18 (Tue) and October 20 (Thu) can be made via the <i>Book Accommodation</i> page on our online registration site (additional fees apply).
Sightseeing Excursion	Reservations for the October 20 (Thu) sightseeing excursion can be made via the <i>Book an Excursion</i> page on our online registration site (additional fees apply). Note 4: The excursion may be cancelled if the number of participants fails to reach the minimum number.
Payment	 Payments for registration fee, accommodation, and excursion should be made by credit card by September 15 (Thu). Note 5: If necessary, documents for visa applications will be issued after payment has been confirmed. Please complete your registration fee payment at the earliest possible date regardless of deadline. Note 6: The registration fee is 100% refundable until September 15. After this date, no refunds will be issued. Please note that after the shipment of visa documents, the registration fee will become nonrefundable, even before the deadline.
